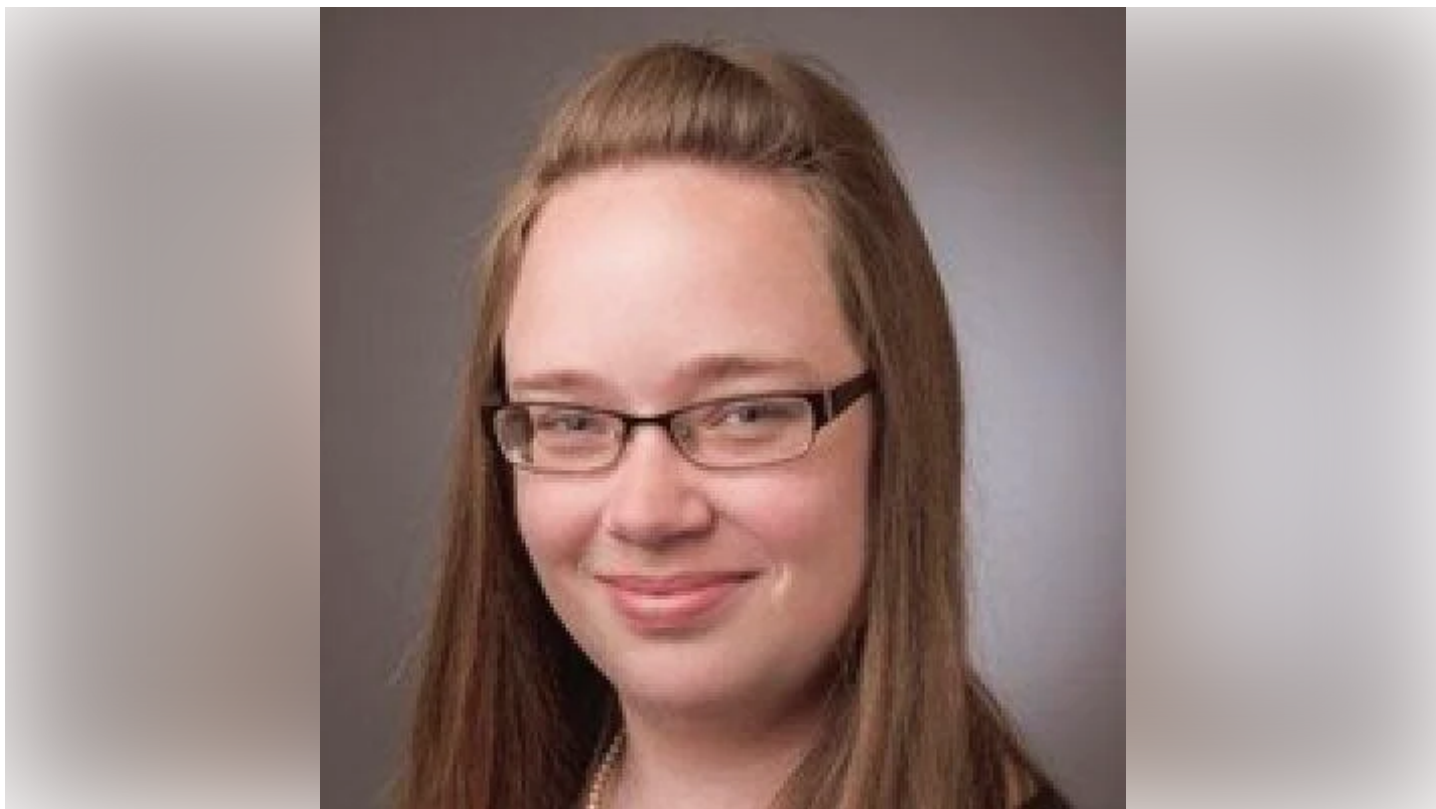

Plainville Community Fund accepting grant applications

PLAINVILLE — The Plainville Community Fund at the Main Street Community Foundation is accepting grant applications through March 21.

“We are now accepting grant applications from nonprofit organizations serving Plainville residents from the Plainville Community Fund,” said Samantha Rajotte, scholarship and program officer with the Main Street Community Foundation. “The organization or the program for which funding is

requested must be located in Plainville and be of benefit to Plainville residents to be eligible for a grant.”

Rajotte said that grant requests should fall within the areas of “basic needs”, “access to opportunity” and “vibrant communities.”

The Plainville Community Fund was established in 2006 by a group of Plainville leaders to create a permanent resource for charitable projects and programs that would enhance the lives of Plainville residents. Since 2006, the Main Street Community Foundation has awarded more than \$144,000 in grants from the Fund, including \$15,000 in grants in 2024.
