In this year's general grant cycle, a total of \$153,364 was awarded to 44 local organizations, all all serving the communities of Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington, and Wolcott.

The following grants were awarded to Southington organizations in the 2024 General Grant Cycle: • <u>Arts for Learning Connecticut</u> - \$4,000 - Express Yourself, a social and emotional resiliency through the arts program to be held at Joseph A. DePaolo Middle School, Southington. (KAWFY Memorial Fund, Lynda M. Mazur and Michael F. Colomonico Jr. Hands-On Fund)

• <u>Bread for Life</u> - \$1,078 - Technology upgrade to support organizational events and data collection as well as the education of clients. (KAWFY Memorial Fund)

 <u>Connecticut Foodshare</u> - \$3,500 - Mobile food pantry supplying meat/dairy/produce to underserved neighborhoods in Bristol, Burlington, and Southington. (Bristol Brass General Grant Fund, Turkus Family Fund)

Blocks of Learning school readiness program for Southington children ages 3-5.
